Dr. Kathy Klimpel is a Sr. Clinical Informaticist at Rady Children's Hospital and a Clinical Associate Professor at the University of San Diego teaching in the Health Care Informatics program. She is currently Board President of the San Diego Regional Chapter of ANIA. She is also a member of the American Medical Informatics Association (AMIA) and is an AMIA Certified Health Informatics Professional (ACHIP) Diplomat. Dr. Klimpel's clinical experience is primarily in the Pediatric ICU setting and has been in St. Louis, Washington, DC & San Diego. She has lived in San Diego since 1996 and those clinical experiences were invaluable as she moved into the role as an informaticist in 2006. Dr. Klimpel has been a leader during implementations of two EHRs (Meditech and Epic) and is certified in two Epic applications. She received her BSN from Rhode Island College, an MSN as a Clinical Nurse Specialist from St. Louis University, and her PhD from the University of San Diego.
