The concept of 'just culture' has been defined in multiple ways since its introduction to the lexicon in high reliability industries such as healthcare. The ability to distinguish the degree of intent, level of culpability, and reason for person's behavioral choices have become an important part of event investigation. Further development of this work has formalized the principles of just culture as a foundational component of both a culture of safety and workplace justice. The speaker will describe the intersection between just culture and a culture of safety with examples from her work as a hospital-based patient safety officer and a consultant.
